



No one from the Embassy contacted Kevin or Gyver Monday in China. As you know it is now midnight there.

Kevin and Gyver live in Hong Kong and thus would have to make a three hour flight to Beijing to attend any meeting. Contacting them on a Tuesday afternoon for a dinner meeting is out of the question.

You will also probably not be terribly surprised to learn that Ricardo called Gyver over the weekend and told him Glas was coming and that Gyver should call the Embassy to arrange a meeting to "talk about many other projects" unrelated to satellites. Gyver said nothing about already knowing this and expecting something from the Embassy.

So it appears Ricardo may be working something with the Ambassador, because no contact was made from the Embassy to us.

Your contacts to Glas need to intervene here, but since he is probably in the air, or even just landing in China, he or they need to set something up for Wednesday to allow Gyver and Kevin time to fly up to Beijing.

Relevant to our ongoing discussions about relations between Ecuador and China, as you know I am in a position to know about many things that go on there.

I can tell you that the damage done by Ricardo Rivera to Ecuador's real relations with China is hard to overestimate. People at the government bureaucracy levels in China talk incessantly among themselves. It is a cultural thing, unlike in our countries where people keep such things to themselves.

This is where the damage was done. When Mr. Rivera told the gathering of senior Chinese space officials and technicians that, and I quote, "Ecuador has no need for a satellite and has no money for it anyway, not even the oil to trade for it" he gave the strong impression not only that Ecuador did not want or need a satellite, but more important, that Ecuador is broke. While of course this is absurd, his statement was shared with China Export Import bank senior officials, who shared it with other important government financial and trade officials. This has created the strong fear in many important circles within China that Ecuador cannot be trusted to pay for anything, neither with currency nor with commodities.

Although we know this is not true, and we have the power and influence to overcome this, it has most definitely created impediments to our helping Ecuador do business with China. As you know, even before Senor Glas went to China, I told you he was going, with whom he was meeting, and that he would be rejected. This was very deliberate - a message from China to Ecuador and a direct result of Ricardo Rivera's statements. China was telling Ecuador that "there is a certain way to do business with us and this is not it." On the other hand, had Senor Glas had the courtesy to contact Mr. Lo, who had received him very graciously on Senor Glas' previous visit, then Mr. Lo would have made sure Senor Glas' trip was successful instead of a failure.

To make matters worse, we learned that on this second and more recent trip, Senor Glas made negative remarks about the idea of a satellite program for Ecuador. This is perhaps why he declined to have contact with Mr. Lo, to whom he had said just the opposite at their original meeting. So on the one hand we have Senor Glas coming to China and expressing great enthusiasm for a satellite program, then we have Mr. Rivera, who was treated like a head of state and had his hotel room and "other amenities" paid for by Genesis while in Beijing, destroying all we had prepared and further damaging Ecuador's credibility in the process. Then, finally, we have Senor Glas return to China on an ill-advised trip, fail to even pay a courtesy call to Mr. Lo, and disparage a satellite program on top of it.

They have created much to overcome. It is not insurmountable, but it certainly makes all of our efforts, and our aspirations, that much more difficult.
